Sanjay Pulipaka was a Pavate Visiting Fellow at the University of Cambridge, UK, and a former Fulbright Fellow in the Conflict Transformation Programme, in the United States. Sanjay's areas of interest include India's foreign policy, Indian politics, India's Look East/Act East Policy, South Asia, China and BRI, the Indo-Pacific, East Asian Security, Myanmar, regional cooperation and connectivity issues. Further, he has been closely following the political transition in Myanmar and conducted field research in that country and in Northeast India. Sanjay also has extensive work experience with think-tanks and civil society organisations in India.
